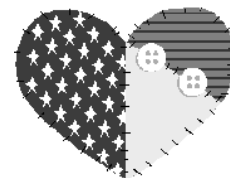

## Consistory Highlights – December

**Editor's Note:** The following notes from the December meeting are for your information only. Minutes and actions of this meeting will not be approved until the January meeting.

The Consistory voted on candidates for the 2007 Consistory Officers. Positions approved at the meeting were: President – Rhonda Shoudel, Vice-President – LiAnne Kitchen and Treasurer – Doth Sysouvanh. Remaining officers will be approved at the January 2007 Consistory meeting.

Installation of new Consistory members will be scheduled in January 2007 pending Rev. Tom Norwalk's availability to conduct the service.



Nominations for the Pastoral Search Committee were reviewed and voted on. Eleven of the twelve positions have been approved. The twelfth

committee member will be approved at the January meeting. The list of committee members will be published in the February issue of *Connections*.

The Consistory is reviewing profiles for the position of Interim Pastor. Additional candidates will be interviewed in January.

The Consistory approved a request by the Parish Nurse to conduct a university Holistic Nursing course at St. Peter's from January through March.

Approval was given to use memorial fund money to purchase a new tree as part of the recent landscaping update. The new evergreen shrubs and rose bushes planted in front of the main entrance were donated.

The Christmas Cantata presented on December 10 was a great success at both St. Peter's and Community UCC.

Building and Grounds reported the condensate problem with the boiler has been repaired.



The Board of Christian Education reported the Youth Christmas Program on December 3 went well. The materials for conducting background checks on youth workers have been received and will be completed shortly.

The Trustees of St. Peter's have received the farm report for the year. The report is available for review.

The Treasurer's report showed the church income exceeded expenses for the month of November.

The Tuesday Evening Circle plans to give their White Gift to the American Legion for a disabled soldier who recently returned from Iraq whose disability checks have not yet started. A request will be made to the congregation to determine if there is interest in a special offering.
